Equipped to Counsel

Biblical Counseling Level 1 Certification / Audited

This class is offered through the Association of Biblical Counselors and was developed by John Hendersion (Professor of Biblical Counseling at The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary). It's mission is to enlist, equip, and encourage followers of Jesus Christ to live and counsel the gospel of Jesus Christ and His Word, especially to those living amidst suffering and the troubles of this life. This is an introductory course of the foundations of biblical counseling.

I believe that this meets our mission for the local church in living out the great commission as well as obeying scripture to equip the saints, admonishing with all wisdom, comfort others with the Comfort of God, and proclaim Christ. (Matt 28; Eph 4; Col 1; 2 Cor 1)

What is being offered:

- A level one certification track (must fulfill all requirements)
- An audited track* (offered the same course but without requirements)

*Auditing participants will have up to a month after the class starts to change their mind to pursue certification.

How Many:

I am hoping for 5 to 15 participants.

Time-Table:

The class is self-paced. The syllabus is laid out for 30 weeks including flex weeks. However, if pursuing certification, they have a year from the start date to complete.
